Panel Discussion with speakers from Quality Organizations of Asia Oceania:

“New Quality Organization Networks support a new Quality Education Initiative in Asia Oceania”

Description: IAQ is willing to address the “global challenge of equity of education quality and learning effectiveness” (UNESCO, 2012). For this purpose, IAQ has meanwhile established the Quality in Education Think Tank (QiETT). As early as at the 1st IAQ/ANQ Symposium in Hong Kong last year, there was a general introduction to the special challenges of Quality in Education (from Basic to Higher Education). In the meantime, there have been the first pilot projects in some Asian countries. At this panel discussion, the panelists will first give a short introduction to the educational systems of the single countries and deal with the question as to whether Quality Organizations of the respective countries could contribute to improvements at all and, if so, to what extent. Then all panelists will discuss the question as to whether the respective Quality Organizations can contribute to additional quality improvements in those countries. Above all, it will be a matter of discussing suggestions for ways to enable New Quality Organization Networks to significantly support the New Quality Education Initiative in Asia Oceania. Last but not least, considerably fostering penetration of Quality Education in the respective countries and Asia Oceania, as a whole, is what it is all about.

Process:

- Opening: The moderator introduces the topic from a global view (see the keynote presentation of the symposium) and gives a brief introduction to the panelists.
- Presentation by each panelist for 10 minutes to share their quality experience in education in their respective home countries. In this context, it will not only be a question of giving a short introduction to the respective educational systems. It is, in particular, a matter of discussing the opportunities for participation that the Quality Organizations in the individual countries have had, up to now, and of initiating pilot projects or opening discussions that will help to improve quality and enhance effectiveness in the future.
- Discussion with all panelists and the audience. On this occasion, the particular focus will be on the extent to which New Quality Organization Networks can support the New Quality Education Initiative in Asia Oceania.
- Summary and closing remarks by the moderator.
