Presentations

The Scientific Program Committee for the IAQ World Quality Forum invites you to submit abstracts for oral or poster or team presentations for the Conference. All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee.

Abstracts for IAQ Panel Presentations can be accepted only from IAQ Members.

The Quality Development Team who intends to present its performance should indicate the name of the Team Leader and how many Team Members will participate at the presentation. The Scientific Program Committee has the right to accept the Team contribution as performance or poster. In both cases Team competitions will be prepared and organized which criteria will be provided with the notification of acceptance before June 30, 2015.

All accepted manuscripts of papers, team and poster presentations (including standby presentations) will be published on CD which will be handed over at registration and will be put on the IAQ website.

In case of acceptance the 1st Speaker/1st Poster Presenter/Team Leader will get 50% discount, the 2nd Author/Team Members 25% discount of the suitable registration fees. The Scientific Program Committee has the right to accept the paper proposals as oral presentation or poster presentation. The instructions to the oral presentation and to preparation of the poster presentations will be provided with the notification of acceptance before June 30, 2015.

Procedure of Abstract Submission

If you wish to present a paper at the IAQ World Quality Forum please submit an abstract online via the $\underline{www.iaq2015.com}$ website, following the steps detailed on the site. Please note that the abstract size should be between 1500 and 2500 characters. Also please submit a short bio/CV of the 1^{st} author (not more than 1500 characters) together with your abstract. "Tutorial Sessions of PhD Students" and Quality Development Team Competition topics are free choice of topics mentioned below.

The abstracts should be submitted not later than April 20, 2015 and should focus on one of the following topics:

- Post-Forum Seminars and Workshops could be organized on October 28 if required.
- The Forum language is English and simultaneous translation will be provided at the Opening and Closing Sessions and at the IAQ Panel Sessions into Hungarian, as well as into other languages if required.
- PhD Students will have to provide signed and stamped confirmation of their status from the institution where they are studying. Identification will be requested when collecting the registration pack at the Forum.
- Best 3 Sessions, 3 Papers, 3 Papers of the PhD Students and 3 Posters as well as the rank of the Teams will be selected by IAQ Committees and announced at the end of the Forum.
